


# NANTWICH FOOD FESTIVAL MAP Wantwich

#### 10. HOSPITAL STREET

Discover the wonderful independent shops cafes and pubs on Hospital Street. Kids can have a go on the miniature train at the Methodist Church while you enjoy refreshments.

#### 11. PILLORY STREET

Visit the popular Nantwich Museum with its local history exhibits and then explore the cafes, shops and pubs along Pillory Street. Enjoy the entertainment and activities in the Cocoa Yard.

#### 12. PEPPER STREET

Explore the eclectic cafes and shops on pretty Pepper Street.

#### 13. MARKET HALL

**Friday and Saturday**: Visit the town's lovely traditional market with fantastic cheese, sweet shop, pies, café, veg stalls and so much more. Plus the monthly Farmers' Market on Saturday

Sunday: Joining the traditional Nantwich Market traders outside will be an Artisan Market from JDL

### 14. DISABLED PARKING

#### 15. ST MARY'S CHURCH

Visit the magnificent St Mary's Church, often referred to as the Cathedral of South Cheshire; refreshments will be served outside the Parish Rooms opposite.

#### 16. FOOD FESTIVAL INFO POINT

Near War Memorial in Town Square.

#### 17. WELSH ROW

A historic Nantwich street, known for its number of beautiful, listed buildings as well as lots of bars. pubs and restaurants to keep you fed and watered!
