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General Health & Safety Legislation & Information

All food traders conducting any cooking activities, including those using large pans, electric hot plates, charcoal grills, ovens, or other cooking equipment should have appropriate fire-fighting equipment and complete fire risk assessments under the UK event safety regulations.

The UK regulations and guidance that this falls under include:

- The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005: Requires all businesses, including temporary food stalls, to assess fire risks and implement controls.
- PAS 79: A widely used standard for conducting fire risk assessments, often adopted by councils and event organisers.
- NCASS (Nationwide Caterers Association): Offers compliance guidance for mobile caterers, including fire extinguisher requirements.
- Local authority guidance.

1. All traders conducting <u>any cooking activities</u> must agree to the following:	Enter Y to confirm
1.1 Use of a Flame Retardant Gazebo/Structure	
1.2 Provision of a Fire Blanket in close proximity to the cooking area	
1.3 Keeping the cooking area clear of combustibles, including combustible waste.	
1.4 Siting cooking equipment / gas cylinders with consideration to combustibles and/or fire hazards outside of your gazebo e.g. trees, other traders' equipment etc.	
1.5 Ensuring any waste is cooled prior to disposal	
1.6 Fighting any small fire where safe to do so	
1.7 Reporting any fire, no matter how small, to the Event Officials immediately	

2. Traders using <u>Electric Hot Plates/Ovens</u> must agree to the following:	Enter Y to confirm
2.1 Provision of a CO ₂ Fire Extinguisher in close proximity to the cooking area	

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3. Traders using <u>Gas Burners</u> must agree to the following:	Enter Y to confirm
3.1 Use of a correct Regulator on Serviced Equipment	
3.2 Provision of a Dry Powder Fire Extinguisher in close proximity to the cooking area	

4. Traders using <u>Oil Fryers/Deep Fat Fryers</u> must agree to the following:	Enter Y to confirm
4.1 Provision of a Wet Chemical Fire Extinguisher in close proximity to the cooking area	

5. Traders using <u>BBQ's/Open Flame</u> must agree to the following:	Enter Y to confirm
5.1 Provision of a Dry Powder Fire Extinguisher in close proximity to the cooking area	
5.2 Provision of a suitable Ash Receptacle
