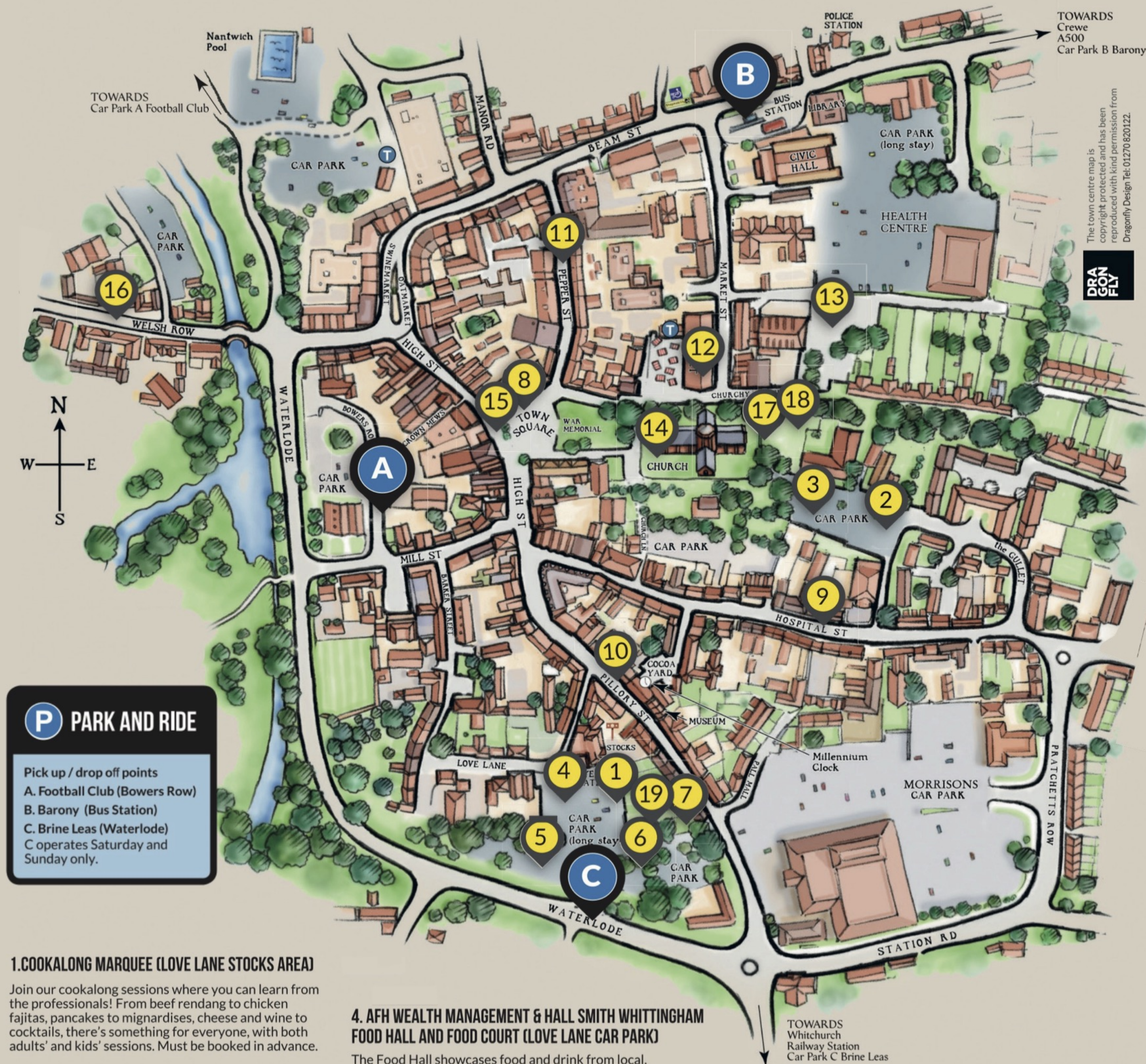




NANTWICH FOOD FESTIVAL MAP

4. AFH WEALTH MANAGEMENT & HALL SMITH WHITTINGHAM FOOD HALL AND FOOD COURT (LOVE LANE CAR PARK)

5. SNUGBURYS MUSIC STAGE (LOVE LANE CAR PARK)

6. REASEHEATH COLLEGE FOOD THEATRE (LOVE LANE CAR PARK)

Watch well-known chefs Lisa Faulkner, Nigel Brown and Jon Watts alongside local chefs and Reaseheath College trainers as they take to the stage for **free** cookery demonstrations.

7. WHITEGATES KIDS CORNER (LOVE LANE CAR PARK)

8. BOUGHEY FOOD MARKET (TOWN SQUARE)

An open market of festival exhibitors offering delicious food and drink in Nantwich's scenic town square, with live music and entertainment throughout the weekend.

9. HOSPITAL STREET

Discover the wonderful independent shops, cafes and pubs on Hospital Street. Kids can have a go on the miniature train at the Methodist Church while you enjoy refreshments.

10. PILLORY STREET

Visit the popular Nantwich Museum with its local history exhibits and then explore the cafes, shops and pubs along Pillory Street.

11. PEPPER STREET

Explore the eclectic cafes, bars and shops on pretty Pepper Street.

12. MARKET HALL

Friday and Saturday: Visit the town's lovely traditional market with fantastic cheese, sweet shop, pies, café, veg stalls and so much more.

Sunday: Joining the traditional Nantwich Market traders outside will be an Artisan Market from JDL Markets.

13. DISABLED PARKING

Disabled parking available close to the town centre throughout the festival at Dysart car park.

14. ST MARY'S CHURCH

Visit the magnificent St Mary's Church, often referred to as the Cathedral of South Cheshire; refreshments will be served outside the Parish Rooms opposite.

15. FOOD FESTIVAL INFO POINT

Visit our information point in the Town Square.

16. WELSH ROW

A historic Nantwich street, known for its number of beautiful, listed buildings as well as lots of bars, pubs and restaurants to keep you fed and watered!

17. DIRECT ACCESS CALM CORNER

A quiet and calming space for visitors with hidden disabilities who need a short rest while attending the festival.

18. FIRST AID TENT

Grassed area opposite the Market Hall.
